## TO MINIMISE THE GAP BETWEEN EDUCATION AND THE LABOUR MARKET IN THE HORECA SECTOR

Nowadays, there is a clear urgency to strengthen the HORECA industry: a sector with high economic growth, but whose working conditions are generally associated with precariousness, seasonality and low professional qualifications, among other drawbacks.

In this context, it is important to address these gaps, and one way to do so is to attract qualified labour. This is where the European project “**HoReCa4VET - Market qualifications - a signpost for minimizing competence gaps between education and the labour market in the HoReCa sector**” arises.

### What are its objectives?

The main objective of the HoReCa4VET project is to **increase access to formal, informal and non-formal lifelong learning** in the HoReCa industry, by developing and implementing validation and certification models according to the European Qualifications Framework.

The skills developed as a result of the project will be able to complement the competences acquired in the framework of formal and non-formal education, as it is a response to the identified labour market needs.
