2ND TRANSNATIONAL MEETING IN CYPRUS

The second transnational meeting took place in EDITC premises in Nicosia Cyprus on the 14th of October 2022.

During the meeting partners discussed the development of Project Result 1 Benchmarking analysis of skills and competences, needs and challenges for Sustainable Waste Management and specifically the finalization of the questionnaire. Partners agreed that there will be four questionnaires, Questionnaire benchmark analysis and Questionnaires for teachers of vocational schools, employees and

representatives of the management staff and set deadlines on conducting the survey and each partners submitting its report.
